

Rules C.L.A.S.A. "Dr. José Delorme" Scientific Prize

CLASA introduces the Scientific Prize "Dr. José Delorme" that will be given to the author of the best scientific paper presented by a Member of an Association affiliated to CLASA during the CLASA CONGRESS URUGUAY 2017.

The Committee that will award the prize will be constituted by five members, designated by the Executive Committee of the Congress.

The Prize will consist of a DIPLOMA and \$ 300 (three hundred American dollars).

The works will be unpublished and original, related to anesthesiology or closely linked to it. They can be presented in Spanish or Portuguese. The method of presentation will be in an electronic poster format.

The author (s) should send an abstract of the work to the Organizing Committee to email ecientifico@clasauruguay.uy until 9/6/2017.

It must have a maximum of 250 words and abbreviations cannot be used neither in the work nor in the title of the study.

The work must be submitted until 9/7/2017.

The verdict of the Committee will be by simple majority and their decisions are unappealable. If deemed appropriate, they may declare the prize null and void.

The works must conform the following characteristics:

- a) They should be organized under the following headings: abstract with key words, introduction, material and methods, results, discussion, conclusions and bibliography (numbered according to its appearance in the text and Vancouver reference style).
- b) The works must be written in Tahoma or Arial fonts, titles size 24 and text size 20.

c) The titles of the works should be brief and, if possible, not exceed 90 letters. In case the title is very long, it is convenient to use subtitles.

d) The name (s) and surname (s) of the author (s) must appear under the title. At the bottom of the page, with an asterisk (s), the title of each author (s), institution where the work was done, country and e-mail of the responsible author must appear. If there were a subsidy for the study, it should also be included below the above.

e) The illustrations must be clear, white background and size 12 x 18 cm. They should be numbered with Arabic numbers at the bottom of the illustration, according to the order of their appearance in the text. Each one of them has to include an explanatory legend to understand its content. In case the figure is explained in the text of the work, the legend should read: "For details, see text of the work".

f) Photographs of individuals should not be identified, unless the author has a signed consent, which must be attached to the work.

g) The tables should also be numbered according to the order of appearance in the text, with Arabic numeral and a short title, the explanatory notes should go in the footnote, as well as the explanation of the abbreviations that are not known.
