

Dr Wayne Morriss is an anaesthesiologist from Christchurch, New Zealand and the current Director of Programmes of the World Federation of Societies of Anaesthesiologists. He was the Chair of the WFSA Education Committee from 2012 to 2016.

He trained in New Zealand and Australia and then worked for two years as a Senior Lecturer at the Fiji School of Medicine in Suva, Fiji. He returned to New Zealand in 2002. Since then, he has remained very active in medical education, with frequent teaching trips to the Pacific region and further afield.
